## Parking in the Village

Residents will be aware that Parking can be a problem in the village is a problem around the pub corner and beyond throughout the year making it difficult for agricultural equipment, fuel and other deliveries to pass through the narrowest part of the village. Goodmanham is an active farming area with a number of local farms relying on the road through the village.

The Council is aware that many of the people parking are not local residents so have contacted East Riding of Yorkshire Council and the Police to see if any further action can be taken.
